- 1. Eligible participants will be the Champion Showmanship winners from the goat, sheep, beef, swine, and horse divisions, in each of the three age groups, Junior, Intermediate and Senior.
- 2. Upon qualifying for Round Robin, exhibitors will have until the conclusion of the horse show to decide if they will exhibit that species in Round Robin or opt out of the Round Robin. If they opt out (give up their spot) they will not be allowed to take it after declining, they must then qualify with another species.

RULES:

- 1. Round Robin participants will be asked to commit themselves to the contest immediately after the Showmanship Class in which they placed Champion.
- 2. PARTICIPANTS ARE REQUIRED TO SHOW THE ANIMAL with WHICH THEY QUALIFY FOR THE ROUND ROBIN. The only exception to this rule is for safety reasons. All substitute animals must be approved by the Superintendents.
- a. If a showman qualifies with more than one species they must declare which species they will use in Round Robin. The Reserve Champion of the remaining species will then have the opportunity to compete.
- 3. Check-In: All Round Robin participants are required to attend an organizational meeting on Saturday morning following the Beef Show in the Show Arena.
- 4. Round Robin Timing: You will show one animal in each of the species divisions. You will exhibit in each species area for approximately 4 minutes total. You will then make a rotation through all of the Large Animal Round Robin Species (beef, goats, horse, sheep, and swine). Participants from each age division will compete at one time, together. You are encouraged to meet the other participants before the show to find out information on, breed, age, etc. that the judge might expect you to know.
- a. Small animal showman will exhibit in each species area for approximately 2 minutes total. You will then rotate to the other species. (rabbit, poultry, water fowl)
 - b. Participants from each age division will compete serprately.
- 5. Tie Breaker: Ties will be broken by a species that the individual has not showed during the year of the county fair.
- 6. Spectators: Spectators will only be allowed in the bleachers of the Show Ring areas, from here they will be able to observe participants in Round Robin. Communication between participants and spectators is not allowed and could result in disqualification of participants.
- 7. The judges decision is final. Winners will be announced as the Round Robin/ Small Animal Showman Champion.
